1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PERMANENT RULES OF THE 1996
2 EXTRA SESSION OF THE NORTH CAROLINA HOUSE OF
3 REPRESENTATIVES.

4 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

5 Section 1. The permanent rules of the 1995 Regular Session of the House
6 of Representatives, with the following amendments, are adopted as the permanent
7 rules of the 1996 Extra Session:

8 (1) Notwithstanding Rule 27, the standing committees of the House
9 are:

10 a. Finance; and

11 b. Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the House.

12 (2) Notwithstanding Rule 31(a), all bills and resolutions shall be
13 introduced by submitting same to the Principal Clerk's office.

14 (3) Notwithstanding Rule 31(g), the only resolutions that may be
15 introduced or considered in the House are resolutions adjourning
16 the Extra Session sine die. All bills shall be excluded from
17 introduction or consideration in the House, other than those
18 requested by the Governor's Proclamation dated January 25, 1996,
19 convening the Extra Session: to enact changes to the Employment
20 Security Law that would implement a zero tax rate for all
21 employers with a positive unemployment insurance tax rate, allow
22 employers with negative tax rates to qualify for the zero tax rate by
23 prepaying taxes, and reduce the assigned rate for new employers
24 from one and eight-tenths percent (1.8%) to one and two-tenths
25 percent (1.2%) and let those employers qualify sooner for a lower
26 rate. Such bill may also include provisions authorizing the

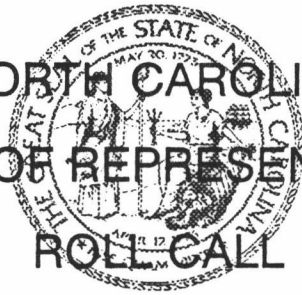

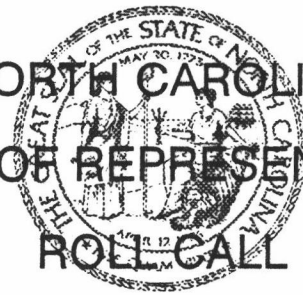

4 Be it resolved by the Senate:

5 Section 1. The permanent rules of the 1995 Regular Session, with the
6 following amendments, are the rules governing the Extra Session, February 1996, of
7 the General Assembly:

8 **Rule 40. Introduction of bills.**

9 Every bill introduced shall contain on the outside cover the title of the document
10 and the name of the Senator or Senators presenting it. Bills shall be delivered by the
11 primary sponsor of the document to the Senate Principal Clerk who shall receive,
12 number, and present said bill to the Senate for first reading.

13 **Rule 40.1. Limitation on resolutions and bills.**

14 The only resolutions that may be introduced or considered in the Senate are
15 resolutions adjourning the Extra Session sine die. All bills shall be excluded from
16 introduction or consideration in the Senate, other than those requested by the
17 Governor's Proclamation dated January 25, 1996, convening the Extra Session: to
18 enact changes to the Employment Security Law that would implement a zero tax rate
19 for all employers with a positive unemployment insurance tax rate, allow employers
20 with negative tax rates to qualify for the zero tax rate by prepaying taxes, and reduce
21 the assigned rate for new employers from one and eight-tenths percent (1.8%) to one
22 and two-tenths percent (1.2%) and let those employers qualify sooner for a lower
23 rate. Such bill may also include provisions authorizing the Legislative Research
24 Commission to study issues relating to the State's Employment Security Law, Chapter
25 96 of the General Statutes.
