Whereas, North Carolina Mutual and Provident Association was chartered by the General Assembly on February 28, 1899, largely due to the efforts of Senator Thomas Oscar Fuller, North Carolina's only African-American senator at that time and the sponsor of the legislation; and

Whereas, North Carolina Mutual and Provident Association began selling burial insurance in April of 1899; and

Whereas, by 1903, North Carolina Mutual and Provident Association hired its first full-time insurance agents and produced its first publication, The North Carolina Mutual, a newspaper that kept the community informed about the Association: and

Whereas, in 1919, North Carolina Mutual and Provident Association's charter was amended, changing its name to North Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Company; and

Whereas, North Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Company is the oldest and largest African-American life insurance company in the United States and the oldest life insurance company in North Carolina; and

Whereas, North Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Company is licensed to operate in 21 states and the District of Columbia and has district and branch offices in 10 states and the District of Columbia; and
