

Claims processing, benefits administration, and eligibility determination processes for the Program shall be as provided under the Medical Assistance Program. The Department may authorize coverage under the Program to be provided by private insurers so long as the private coverage meets the requirements for coverage under the Program and under Title XXI, and the cost of the private coverage is equal to or less than the cost of equivalent coverage under the Program.
