12 and the name of the Senator or Senators presenting it. Bills shall be delivered by the
13 primary sponsor of the document to the Senate Principal Clerk within one hour after
14 adoption of this resolution. The Principal Clerk shall receive, number, and present
15 said bill to the Senate for first reading.

16 **Rule 40.1. Limitation on resolutions and bills.**

17 The only resolutions that may be introduced or considered in the Senate are
18 resolutions adjourning the Extra Session sine die. No bills, parts thereof, or
19 amendments thereto may be introduced or considered in the Senate unless requested
20 by the Governor's Proclamation dated December 9, 1999, convening the Extra
21 Session: for the purpose of authorizing the use of the Budget Stabilization Reserve
22 and the remaining credit balance in the General Fund on June 30, 1999, and making
23 changes in law necessary to expedite, for recovery assistance in Eastern North
24 Carolina. This rule may not be suspended.
