FIRST DAY

Senate Chamber Thursday, March 20, 2008

In accordance with law, as set forth in the Constitution of the State of North Carolina and pursuant to the Proclamation issued by the Governor, the Honorable Michael F. Easley, on March 11, 2008, the Senate of the 2007 General Assembly convenes in Second Extra Session 2008 at the hour of 10:00 A.M. in the Senate Chamber of the Legislative Building in the City of Raleigh.

The Honorable Beverly E. Perdue, Lieutenant Governor, presides and calls the Senate to order.

Prayer is offered by The Reverend Mike Morris, Senate Chaplain, as follows:

"Dear God, it is good to see the Lieutenant Governor, some of the Senators and staff in the Chamber today. One thing is becoming increasingly clear. The Session that begins in May needs no prelude or practice run. Interest in the political landscape of our State and our Country by voters is at a very high level and almost everyone in the Senate is running for some State office. The upcoming Session will be challenging and exciting, if not at times a little distracting. So we begin today praying early and often for all that lies ahead. In your holy name we pray, Amen."

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Led by the President, members and guests remain standing and pledge allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

PROCLAMATION

The President instructs the Reading Clerk to read the Proclamation issued by Governor Michael F. Easley, on March 11, 2008, as follows:

PROCLAMATION OF AN EXTRA SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor by Article III, Section 5(7) of the Constitution of North Carolina, and by and with the advice of the Council of State, the General Assembly of North Carolina shall convene for an extra session on Thursday, March 20, 2008, at 10:00 a.m. in order for the House of Representatives, (i) under Article II, Section 20 of the Constitution of North Carolina, to judge the qualifications of Representative Thomas Wright to

continue to serve the 18th House District of the House of Representatives, General Assembly of North Carolina, and/or (ii) within its inherent power to discipline its members, to impose any sanctions against Representative Thomas Wright of the 18th House District.

ADOPTION OF RULES

Senator Rand submits Senate Resolution 1 which is read and disposed of as follows:

By Senator Rand:

S.R. 1, A SENATE RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PERMANENT RULES OF THE SENATE FOR THE 2008 EXTRA SESSION OF THE 2007 GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

Upon motion of Senator Rand, the resolution is placed before the Senate for immediate consideration, upon adoption.

The text of Senate Resolution 1 is as follows:

A SENATE RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PERMANENT RULES OF THE SENATE FOR THE 2008 EXTRA SESSION OF THE 2007 GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

Be it resolved by the Senate:

SECTION 1. The permanent rules of the 2007 Regular Session, with the following amendments, are the rules governing the 2008 Extra Session of the 2007 General Assembly:

RULE 32. Standing/select committees. -

The only standing committee shall be Rules and Operations of the Senate. That committee shall be comprised of the members who were appointed to it during the 2007 Regular Session.

RULE 40. Introduction of resolutions. -

Every resolution introduced shall contain on the outside cover the title of the document and the name of the Senator or Senators presenting it. The Principal Clerk of the Senate shall receive, number, and present each resolution to the Senate for first reading.

March 20, 2008

RULE 40.1. Limitation on introduction and consideration of resolutions and bills. -

No bills may be introduced during the 2008 Extra Session. The only resolutions that may be introduced or considered in the Senate are resolutions adjourning the 2008 Extra Session sine die.

RULE 43. First reading; reference to committee. –

All resolutions introduced and all House joint resolutions received upon a message from the House of Representatives, upon presentation to the Senate, shall be read in the regular order of business by their number and title which shall constitute the first reading. The Chair of the Rules and Operations of the Senate Committee or, in the Chair's absence, the Vice-Chair of that Committee may place a joint resolution adjourning the 2008 Extra Session sine die upon the Senate calendar for immediate consideration without referring it to committee or may refer it to committee.

RULE 43.1. Second reading. -

All resolutions adjourning the 2008 Extra Session shall when placed upon the calendar be considered for second reading and immediate consideration upon passage.

RULE 50. Third reading requirements. –

When a resolution has passed its second reading, it shall be placed on the calendar for immediate consideration on its third reading.

RULE 56.1. Amendments and committee substitutes adopted by the House to resolutions originating in the Senate. –

(a) Whenever the House has adopted an amendment or a committee substitute for a joint resolution originating in the Senate and has returned the resolution to the Senate for concurrence in that amendment or committee substitute, the Senate may concur in that amendment or committee substitute on the same legislative day.

RULE 59. (Reserved).

SECTION 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.

Upon motion of Senator Rand, Senate Resolution 1 is adopted.
