In accordance with Section 120-157 .2(a) of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended, the Town of Southern Pines, North Carolina (the "Town") hereby notifies you of its intent to enter into a Clean Water Revolving Fund Loan (the "Loan") with the Division of Water Quality in the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources subject to the approval of the Local Government Commission, in the expected amount of not to exceed \$2,998,000. The proceeds of the Loan will be used to finance certain wastewater system improvements, including, but not limited to, the relocation of the Town's Warrior Woods Sewer Pump Station.
