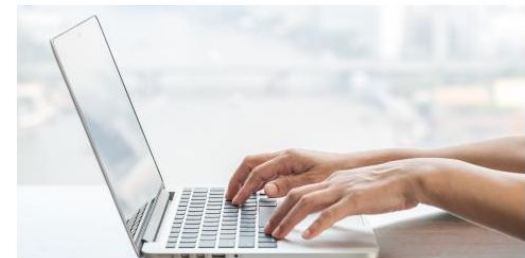
Making Number Talks Work in the K-5 Classroom - Online
