



# Monthly Medicaid Enrollment by Month, Actual & Forecast (Excl. Family Planning)



**SFY 2022** final results continued NC Medicaid's trend of finishing the year under budget.







### **Highlights of SFY 2023 Budget**

Budget Item	Appropriations (millions)	
Medicaid Rebase	\$ 83.5	R/NR
PACE Rate Increase	6.0	R
FQHC Increased Payments	4.4	NR
Transformation Projects and Programs	230.0	NR
Continue Enhanced Skilled Nursing (SNF) and Personal Care Services (PCS, including Community Alternatives Program/CAP) Rates	95.0	NR

**Note:** \$14.5 m R for Medicaid costs for SA-IH was appropriated in SL 2021-180, but did not begin until SFY 2022-23.
