Dear Dr. Whitney Oakley:

We acknowledge receipt of the 2022-2023 Individual Class Size Waiver Request(s) received from Guilford County Schools for Gibsonville Elementary.

G.S. 115C-301(g) prohibits the State Board of Education from granting waivers for Kindergarten through third-grade individual class size overages except under the following circumstances:

- a) Emergencies, or acts of God that impact the availability of classroom space or facilities;
- b) An unanticipated increase in student population of an individual school in excess of two percent (2%) of the average daily membership of that school;
- c) Organizational problems in geographically isolated local school administrative units in which the average daily membership is less than one and one-half per square mile;
- d) Classes organized for a solitary curricular area; or
- e) A charter school closure.

Guilford County Schools requested waivers for the following school based on an unanticipated increase in student population of an individual school in excess of two percent (2%) of the average daily membership of that school as stated above. The request for class size waivers meets the criteria as set out by law and are **approved**. These waivers apply only to the 2022-23 school year.

Gibsonville Elementary has 4 individual third grade classes with 22 students (over by 2) and 1 individual third grade class with 21 students (over by 1).
