





#### North Carolina Undergraduate Enrollment

- Negative Impact of more than \$20M loss in 2011 and 2012 from \$108M in State Aid
- North Carolina enrollment had been increasing until 2011 but has been declining each year since that loss of aid
- We appreciate the General Assembly's support to provide increases to \$91M currently

### **NCICU by the Numbers**

Almost 16K North Carolinians received the NCNBS in 2021-2022 Per student appropriation: \$2,964 Average grant: \$5,280

Almost half of our North Carolina students qualified for federal Pell Grants which are awarded to low-income students



## **Request for Support**

\$8.5mR increase for the NCNBS

**\$750kR** to provide tuition assistance grants for North Carolinians who graduate from NCSSM or NCSA

**\$15m** for Growing the Health Care Workforce

**\$3mR** in grant funding to NCICU to support **8** principal preparation programs
