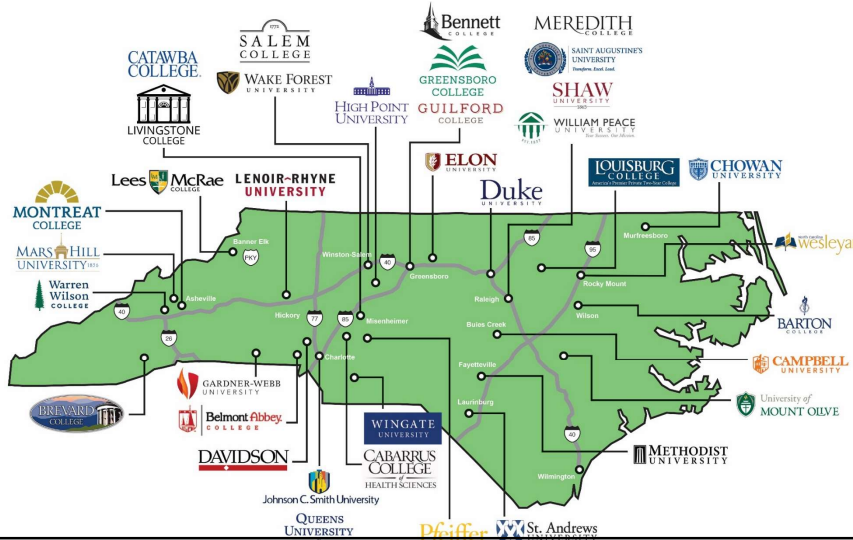

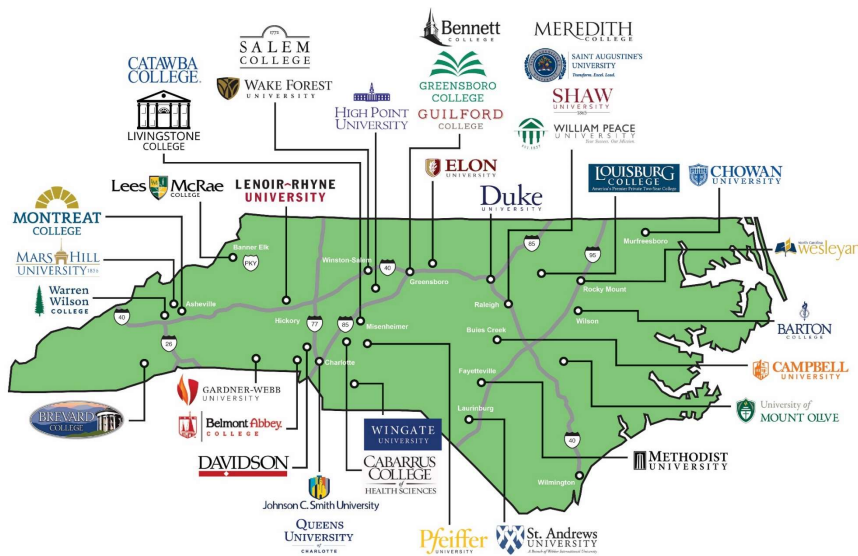

## North Carolina Undergraduate Enrollment

- **Negative Impact of more than \$20M loss in 2011 and 2012 from \$108M in State Aid**
- **North Carolina enrollment had been increasing until 2011 but has been declining each year since that loss of aid**
- **We appreciate the General Assembly's support to provide increases to \$91M currently**
