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# Financial Impacts of the Pandemic

- Impacts on Students and Families
  - Shift to online and hybrid instruction
  - Significant impacts on campus life/student activities
  - Student physical and mental health
  - Disruptions impacting educational progress
- Impact on Institutions
  - Shift to online and hybrid instruction
  - COVID mitigation (social distancing, cleaning, testing, contact tracing, quarantine and isolation space)
  - Impact on operations, particularly auxiliaries
  - Employee physical and mental health



# **Multiple Streams of Federal Funding**

### HEERF

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund

- Administered by US Dept. of Education
- Awarded directly to higher ed institutions
- Three phases
- HEERF I CARES Act
- HEERF II CRRSAA
- HEERF III American Rescue Plan (ARP)

### Federal funds appropriated by NC General Assembly

- S.L. 2020-4: 2020 COVID-19 Recovery Act
- S.L. 2020-80: Coronavirus Relief Fund/Additions & Revisions
- S.L. 2020-97: Coronavirus Relief Act 3.0
- S.L. 2021-180: Current Appropriations Act of 2021

### **GEER**

Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund

- Administered by US Dept. of Education
- Awards determined by Governor's Office
- Includes unobligated EANS funds, which must be used for GEER purposes
- Two phases
- GEER I/EANS I
- GEER I/EANS II

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
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## **HEERF** Awards

HEERF Category	Total Awards (CARES, CRRSSA, & ARP)	% Expended (as of Dec. 31, 2022)
<b>Student Aid Portion:</b> The minimum amount institutions were required to use for making emergency financial aid grants to students.	\$435.6 million	97%
<b>Institutional Portion:</b> Funds must be used to defray expenses associated with coronavirus or make additional emergency financial grants to students.	\$535.7 million	90%
HBCU/MSI/SIP Funds: Additional funding provided to institutions meeting federal Historically Black Colleges and Universities, Minority Serving Institutions, and Strengthening Institutions Program criteria.	\$319.9 million	65%
TOTAL	\$1.29 billion
