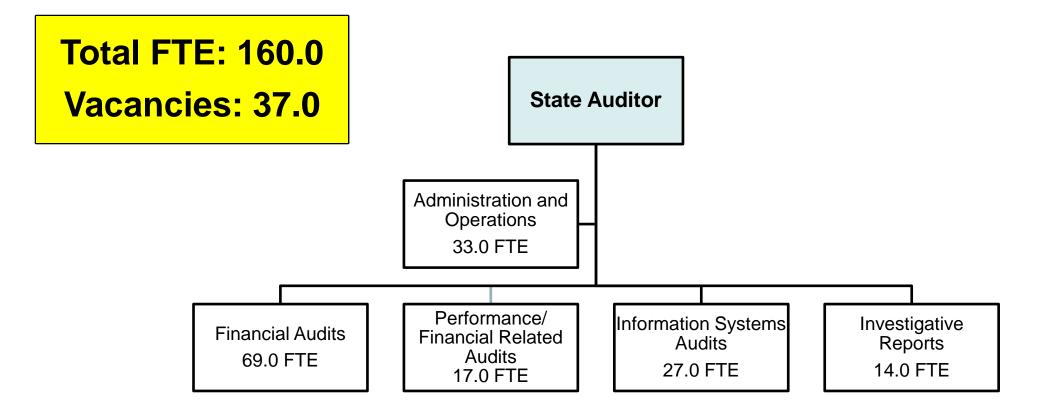
Authorizing Laws & Responsibilities

- NC State Constitution, Article III
 - Constitutional Officer
 - Duties delegated by the General Assembly
 - Council of State Member

<u>Authorizing Laws & Responsibilities</u>

- Chapter 147, Article 5A
 - Audits State agencies and entities receiving
 State funds
 - Investigates reports of improper governmental activities
 - Accesses financial records to conduct audits
 - Contracts outside services as needed

Key takeaways

- Reversions are usually the result of vacant positions
- Average reversions typically exceed Statewide average

Audits and Investigations

- Financial Statement Audits
 - Determine whether an agency's financial statements are a fair and accurate representation of its transactions
- Performance Audits
 - Evaluate agency operations
 - May include program outcomes
- Financial Related Audits
 - Evaluate agency management practices
 - Do not include program outcomes

Audits and Investigations

- Information Systems Audits
 - Analyze information system risks
 - Evaluate controls in place to mitigate risks
 - Verify the suitability and efficiency of agency information systems
- Investigative Reports
 - Investigate tips submitted through the State Auditor's hotline alleging fraud, waste, or abuse by any entity receiving State funds
 - Refers cases to appropriate agency for further investigation if needed
