The Economic Development Partnership of North Carolina (“EDPNC”) is required to submit an annual report to the N.C. Department of Commerce regarding the State’s new North Carolina Megasite Fund, per SL2022-74. The report is to include *“the total amount of grants awarded, matching funds required, activities to ready megasites and associated costs, any major employers locating at an improved or acquired megasite, and the unallocated amount for grants remaining in the Fund.”* As of the time of this report, the Fund has not received an appropriation and, thus, no grants have been awarded and no subsequent activities as noted above have occurred.
