This number reflects the number of applications received during this Fiscal year; however, there may have been applicants pending from the previous year that were issued a license after 07/01/2022.

There were 68 applications received with conviction records, and 67 licenses granted; with one application pending Board review. There were no applications denied due to conviction.

There were 52 applications received with military training, and 47 licenses granted; with 5 applicants pending additional information needed.

10. The Board is working with the NC Chapter of the National Association of Social Workers to get SB718 the Social Work Licensure Compact bill passed. The compact legislation requires adoption by at least seven states before the commission may convene and the compact may begin offering multistate licenses.
