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HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA ENDORSEMENTS

In response to NCGS 115C-12(40), Increase Access to Career and Technical Education, the State Board of Education (SBE) established three high school diploma endorsements to encourage students to provide a more comprehensive student profile indicating credentials and rigorous pathway of study upon graduating from high school, to obtain requisite job skills, and to reduce the need for remedial education in institutions of higher education. SBE established these three high school diploma endorsements in collaboration with UNC System Office (UNCSO) and NC Community College System Office (NCCCSO). These endorsements are based on the Career and College Readiness definitions and minimum admissions requirements or remediation-free placement policies at the UNCSO and NCCCSO from 2014-15.

The three legislated high school diploma endorsements are: Career, College, and College/UNC. These diploma endorsements encourage career and college readiness and reflect course completion and grade achievement. Table 1 is an overview of the number of graduates in 2022-2023 who earned the Career, College and College/UNC diploma endorsements. Note that graduates may earn more than one endorsement. Tables 2, 3, and 4 give further detailed information of each diploma endorsement by each Public School Unit (PSU).

Please note that last year was the fourth year that the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI) implemented the legislative requirement that students shall only receive a high school diploma endorsement when the student achieves at least the benchmark reading score established by a nationally norm-referenced college admissions test. Due to the addition of this requirement, diploma endorsements remain lower than reported for the 2018-2019 school year.

Students in North Carolina public schools and public charter schools may earn one or more endorsements on their high school diploma. These endorsements indicate that students have completed specific course concentrations preparing them to be ready for careers and/or college. To earn one of the three high school diploma endorsements, students shall meet the requirements for each endorsement listed below.

College/UNC Endorsement Criteria

The student shall:

- complete a Future-Ready Core mathematics sequence with a fourth-level math course that meets University of North Carolina Minimum Course Requirements (UNCMRC);
- complete three units of science including at least one physical science with a lab, one life science and one additional science course,
- complete the UNCMCR for social studies,
- complete two units of a world language (other than English),
- earn a weighted GPA of at least 2.5, and
- earn at least the benchmark reading score on the ACT (22) or SAT (480).

College Endorsement Criteria

The student shall:

- complete a Future-Ready Core mathematics sequence with a fourth math course that meets is acceptable for earning placement in a credit-bearing college math class under the North Carolina Community College System's Multiple Measures Placement policy and:
- earn an unweighted GPA of at least 2.6, and
- earn at least the benchmark reading score on the ACT (22) or SAT (480).

Career Endorsement Criteria:

The student shall:

- complete a Future-Ready Core mathematics sequence with a fourth math course and:
- complete a CTE concentration in one of the approved CTE career pathways,
- earn an unweighted GPA of at least 2.6,
- earn an industry-recognized credential (or a WorkKeys assessment score of Silver or above), and
- earn at least the benchmark reading score on the ACT (22) or SAT (480).

2022-2023 GRADUATES DATA SUMMARY:

With the ACT/SAT Benchmark Reading Requirement:

- A total of 68,029 high school diploma endorsements were awarded to 2022-2023 graduates. **This represents an increase of 26% from the previous year.**
- In 2022-2023, 27,873 graduates earned a College/UNC endorsement. This represents a 2% increase from the previous year.
- In 2022-2023, 27,849 graduates earned a College Endorsement. This represents a 2% increase from the previous year.
- In 2022-2023, 12,284 graduates earned a Career endorsement. This represents a 6% increase from the previous year.
- In 2022-2023, 11,282 graduates earned all three endorsements. This represents an increase of 6% increase in graduates from the previous year.

Without the ACT/SAT Benchmark Reading Requirement:

- A total of 149,224 (18% more) high school diploma endorsements would have been awarded without the ACT/SAT benchmark reading requirement. **The number of endorsements that would have been awarded without the requirement represents a 16% increase from the previous year.**
- In 2022-2023, 56% of graduates would have earned the College/UNC endorsement

without the ACT/SAT benchmark reading requirement compared to 26% that did earn the endorsement. The number of endorsements that would have been awarded without the requirement represents no change from the previous year.

- In 2022-2023, 56% of graduates would have earned the College endorsement without the ACT/SAT benchmark reading requirement compared to 26% that did earn the endorsement. The number of endorsements that would have been awarded without the requirement represents no change from the previous year.
- In 2022-2023, 26% of graduates would have earned a Career endorsement without the ACT/SAT benchmark reading requirement compared to 11% that did earn the endorsement. The number of endorsements that would have been awarded without the requirement represents a 15% increase from the previous year.
- In 2022-2023, 21% of graduates would have earned all three endorsements without the ACT/SAT benchmark reading requirement compared to 10% that did earn the endorsement. The number of endorsements that would have been awarded without the requirement represents a 12% increase from the previous year.

Data Analysis:

Overall, diploma endorsement attainment from the 2022-2023 school year continues to remain lower than reported for the 2018-2019 school year but is showing a greater increase compared with attainment over the last three years. This overall lower attainment over the past four years is due to the addition of the benchmark reading score from a nationally norm-referenced college admissions test, either the ACT or SAT, as a predictive criterion for success in college courses. This decrease was expected due to the average ACT/SAT scores typically received by NC's public school students. The average ACT/SAT scores are often lower than the benchmark

reading score of 22* for the ACT or 480 for the SAT. This factor can explain the significant decrease in endorsements awarded over the past four reporting years. Additionally, PSUs only receive one ACT score from the NCDPI administered assessment in 11th grade and do not receive an SAT score. Students must bring in other updated scores if they would like them to be considered for this recognition.

2022-2023 had the greatest increase in diploma endorsement attainment compared to the last four years. There was an increase in all three endorsements as well as total endorsements and all three endorsements earned. Total endorsements earned had the largest increase at 26% from the previous reporting year. This increase is significant considering the total endorsements earned from 2020-2021 to 2021-2022 showed a 1% decrease. The COVID pandemic was most likely the contributing factor of the decrease from 2020-2021 to 2021-2022. Students that earned all three endorsements and Career Endorsements both increased by 6%. College and College/UNC Endorsements increased by 2%. It should be noted that there was a 6% increase from the 2021-2022 to the 2022-2023 graduating cohorts. The data from this year suggests that great gains are being made to remedy the effects of the pandemic.

As anticipated, the number of 2022-2023 Career Endorsements has shown a substantial increase from the 2021-2022 reporting year. This anticipated increase may be due to additional monies allocated for credentialing opportunities by the General Assembly. NCDPI has observed an increase in credential attainment over the last two years of all CTE students in grades 9 through 12. NCDPI anticipates this attainment will continue to increase as districts focus on earning higher percentages of their credential potential specifically aligned to students' career pathways. With increased funding for credentialing efforts, more students will have access to high-quality credentials than in past years. Furthermore, CTE state consultants continue to actively seek credentialing opportunities that align with the CTE curriculum and enhance coursework.

**NOTE: The minimum eligibility requirement for admission consideration to a UNC System school is an ACT composite score of 19.*

HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA ENDORSEMENTS

The State Board of Education/NC Department of Public Instruction is unable to determine a direct causal relationship of high school diploma endorsements on high school graduation, college acceptance, college remediation, and post-high school employment.

Furthermore, NCDPI is unable to accurately determine how many times a student retakes a nationally norm-referenced exam since additional test results must be disclosed by the parent. The above results are primarily based on students' 11th grade ACT reading outcomes which NCDPI administers as part of its testing and accountability program.

Career and Technical Education

In accordance with Section 3.2.(a) G.S. 115C-156.2(b), the Office of Career and Technical Education (CTE) reports the number of students in CTE courses who earned (i) community college credit and (ii) related industry certifications and credentials for the 2022-23 school year.

Career and College Promise credits

Eligible NC students can take community college CTE courses through Career and College Promise (CCP). Community college CTE credits were earned by 35,612 students across 191 Public School Units (PSUs), which include school districts and charter schools. Table 1 displays the number of students earning high school credits through community college CTE courses. **Note:** Numbers less than 10 are displayed as “<10” to protect personal information.

Credentials recognized by North Carolina CTE are a valid proof of learning typically endorsed by business and industry and provide documentation for student mastery of skills required for employment and advancement in a career. During the 2022-2023 school year, 207,776 students earned 325,784 individual industry-recognized credentials.
