Outreach Efforts 2021-2022

The Summer of 2021, Crime Victim Compensation Services launched a public communications and outreach campaign to raise awareness and to engage underserved and rural communities across the state of the programs and services Victim Compensation Services offers. This was an intense three month media push. The campaign utilized multiple media formats to include various social media outlets, television, radio, newspaper, display banners, and DMV video boards. This outreach effort was expanded into 2022 and is ongoing. Additionally, VCS staff conducts outreach targeting specific agencies (funeral home, social services, college campuses) providing education and program information. In April 2022 the Office of Victim Services also conducted a panel discussion to provide program information to agencies who target underserved populations.
