Overview of the Process – G.S. 150B-21.3



Effective Dates

- If disapproval bill not introduced, rule becomes effective on 31st legislative day
 - “Legislative day” – a day in which either house of the General Assembly meets in regular session.
- Disapproval bill introduced and enacted, rule does not become law
- If disapproval bill introduced but not enacted, rule becomes effective when unfavorable final action is taken on the bill or the day that session of the General Assembly adjourns
 - “Day of adjournment” – adjourns for more than 30 days in odd-numbered year or sine die in even-numbered year
