#### All Licensing Boards

 Annual Report to the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs

### Occupational Licensing Boards

- Defined in G.S. 93B-1(2) as:
  - "Any board, committee, commission, or other agency in North Carolina which is established for the primary purpose of regulating the entry of persons into, and the conduct of persons within, a particular profession or occupation, and which is authorized to issue licenses."
- Does not include State agencies, staffed by full-time State employees, which as part of their regular functions may issue licenses.
- Commonly referred to as "Independent" Occupational Licensing Boards.

### Annual Reports | Subsection (a)

- Basic Information about the Board
- Total Number of Licensees
- Number of Applicants/LicensesGranted
- Licensing Examination
- License by Reciprocity or Comity
- Complaints, Disciplinary Actions, Licenses Suspended/Revoked

- Applicants with Conviction Records
- Applicants who are Active-Duty Military/Military Veterans
- Applicants who are Military Spouses
- Anticipated Legislative Proposals
- Anticipated Rule Changes

### Annual Reports | Subsection (a), continued

- Must be Submitted Electronically to:
  - Secretary of State
  - Attorney General
  - Joint Legislative Administrative Procedure Oversight Committee

Due October 31

### Financial Reports | Subsection (b)

 The Source and Amount of All Funds Credited to the Occupational Licensing Board

 The Purpose and Amount of All Funds Disbursed by the Occupational Licensing Board during the Previous Fiscal Year

### Financial Reports | Subsection (b), continued

- Must be Submitted Electronically to:
  - Secretary of State
  - Attorney General
  - Joint Legislative Administrative Procedure Oversight Committee
  - Office of State Budget and Management
- Due October 31

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### State Agency Licensing Boards

- "Any State agency staffed by full-time State Employees, which as part of their regular functions issues licenses."
- G.S. 93B-1(3) provides a nonexclusive list of State agency licensing boards to which this reporting requirement applies.
- Exemptions:
  - North Carolina Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards Commission
  - North Carolina Sheriff's Education and Training Standards Commission
  - North Carolina Department of Revenue

### State Agency Licensing Board | Subsection (e)

### "Mini" Annual Reports

- Number of Applicants for License/Licenses
  Granted
- Applicants with Conviction Records
- Applicants who are Active-Duty Military/Military Veterans
- Applicants who are Military Spouses

- Must be Submitted Electronically to:
  - Secretary of State
  - Attorney General
  - Joint Legislative Administrative
    Procedure Oversight Committee
- Due October 31

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### All Licensing Boards | Subsection (b1)

- Report to the Secretary of the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs:
  - Number of Applicants who are Active-Duty Military/Military Veterans
  - Number of Applicants who are Military Spouses
- Due October 31

### Failure to Submit 93B Reports | Subsection (d)

- Joint Legislative Administrative Procedure Oversight Committee is directed to notify any licensing board that fails to submit the reports required by G.S. 93B-2
- Failure of a board to comply with these reporting requirements could result in the suspension of the board's authority to expend funds.
