Remaining Program Milestones: (completed / completed this month)

- ➤ *ISV Office (ISV) completed Eugenics records searches*
- > JSV prepared remaining files for Industrial Commission (IC) by September 30, 2014
- > JSV finalized process for Qualified Recipient outreach prior to checks being mailed
- ➤ JSV finalized Pro Bono assistance process from NC Bar Association
- > JSV made outreach calls to Qualified Recipients ongoing
- > JSV sent information packet to Qualified Recipients ongoing
- ➤ IC completed initial determinations October 15, 2014
- > ISV and IC calculated INITIAL payment with supporting documentation
- ➤ Office of the State Controller (OSC) created NCAS vendor file and prepared checks
- ➤ JSV distributed INITIAL payments prior to October 31, 2014 deadline 214 checks mailed on 10/28/14 (6 held until necessary documentation received; all victims contacted and all indicated they planned to send documentation as soon as possible);
- > JSV distributed remaining checks upon receipt of completed documentation requirements
- > IC continues to address motions for reconsideration and conduct hearings ongoing
- ➤ JSV and IC perform additional searches at Archives upon request of IC Deputy Commissioner ongoing
- ➤ JSV, IC and OSC collaborate on distributing INITIAL payments to any newly Qualified Recipient identified as a result of Appeal as needed
- > JSV and IC address initial archive requirements October -December
- > JSV makes plans to close the office by June 30, 2015
- > JSV and IC calculate FINAL payment with supporting documentation time TBD
- ➤ JSV, IC and OSC distribute FINAL payments within 60 days of the last appeal being exhausted time TBD

Outreach Efforts Completed:

- Letters mailed to 800+ potential victims who had contacted the office previously;
- ➤ Daily calls with claimants to discuss the process; answer questions and provide additional support
- Follow up research on returned mail to identify a correct mailing address;
- ➤ Multiple follow up letters mailed to 400+ claimants identifying missing claim information;
- > JSV website is routinely updated with pertinent information;
- ➤ JSV flier and tri-fold brochure circulated to the CFW, CIA, HRC and DHHS for distribution through their various channels to > 1,400 locations across NC;
- > ISV information added to the DMV's closed circuit Motor Vehicle Network;
- > UNC Center for Civil Rights/NC Bar Association providing pro bono legal assistance:
- Personal visit to victim's home in Halifax County to assist with claim form completion
- > Over 50 media interviews completed
- ➤ Successfully lobbied for procedural and technical changes to the Eugenics Compensation program to allow for initial payments to occur by 10/31/14.

- > NC Bar Association volunteer attorneys providing pro bono legal assistance relative to tax and estate planning
- > JSV contacted all Qualified Recipients to verify addresses and inquire as to their readiness to receive and handle a large check
- > JSV continues contact with Qualified Recipients to ensure all necessary documentation has been submitted in order to receive payments
