

Longleaf Commitment Community College Grant Program Report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee

September 1, 2024

Background.

- 2022 High School Graduates. The Longleaf Commitment Community College Grant Program (Longleaf) was included in Session Law 2021-180, Section 8A.5 and was funded with State Fiscal Recovery Funds (SFRF). The legislation directed the State Education Assistance Authority (SEAA) to administer the grant program for grants to eligible students graduating from high school or receiving a high school equivalency diploma during the 2021-2022 school year to cover tuition and fees at a community college for up to two years. The goal of the grant program was to help students who graduated from a North Carolina high school during the COVID-19 pandemic recover learning and persist through to degree attainment.
- 2023 High School Graduates. In Session Law 2023-134, Section 8A.7 provided funding for the Longleaf Commitment Grant Program from the Escheat Fund and the General Fund to continue Longleaf for eligible students graduating from high school or receiving a high school equivalency during the 2022-2023 school year to cover tuition and fees at a community college for up to two years.

Eligibility. In addition to graduating from high school or receiving a high school equivalency diploma, eligible students must also meet the following criteria:

- (1) Qualify as a resident for tuition purposes under the criteria set forth in G.S. 116-143.1 and in accordance with the coordinated and centralized residency determination process administered by SEAA.
- (2) Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year.
- (3) Have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) below fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000).
- (4) Enrolls in the fall or spring semester following high school graduation or receiving a high school equivalency and maintain enrollment in at least six credit hours per semester in curriculum courses at a community college.

Award Amounts. Grants awarded under the Program are for a minimum amount of \$700 per eligible student with a maximum grant of up to \$2,800 per eligible student per year for up to two years, which includes cost of tuition and a fee allowance.

Reporting. For both high school cohorts, SEAA was directed to submit initial and final reports that include, for each academic year, the amount of grant funds disbursed and the number of eligible students receiving funds.

2022 High School Graduates: 2023-2024 Awards. For the 2023-2024 academic year, SEAA disbursed a total of **\$3,427,030** to **5,394** eligible students.
