Pursuant to § 143B-344.21, the Advisory Commission of the North Carolina Museum of Natural Sciences is to submit a Report by October 1 of each year to the General Assembly, Fiscal Research Division of the General Assembly, and the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations.

Given that our Report is to include an outline of the Museum's needs and recommendations of any changes to improve the Museum's effectiveness, and given the several references to the Museum in the State's just released 2015-16 Budget, each of which has an operational and planning impact, and given the consultative involvement of the Commission's Statewide membership in the finalization of the Report, this is an interim note to respectively request that the Commission be permitted to submit its Report on or before October 14, 2015.
