The Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Rural Heath respectfully submits this Legislative Report to satisfy SL 2023-134, Section 9B.2.(e) on the Community Health Grant Program.

Session Law 2023-134 directed the Office of Rural Health (ORH) to report the following information on the Community Health Grant Program:

- The identity and a brief description of each grantee and each program or service offered by the grantee.
- The amount of funding awarded to each grantee.
- The number of individuals served by each grantee, and for the individuals served, the types of services provided to each.
- Any other information requested by the Office of Rural Health as necessary for evaluating the success of the Community Health Grant Program.

The Community Health Grant Program was established and funded by the North Carolina General Assembly in 2005 (S.L. 2005-276) to increase access to preventive and primary care services for uninsured or medically indigent patients. Since the Community Health Grant Program's inception, ORH has worked collaboratively with stakeholders and representatives of key safety net providers to obtain input that ORH used to guide its administration of the Community Health Grant Program. In Session Law 2017-57, the Community Health Grant Program funding expanded, the program criteria were defined, and the Primary Care Advisory Committee was formalized. ORH worked directly with the Primary Care Advisory Committee members which includes the North Carolina Community Health Center Association, the North Carolina Association of Local Health Directors, the North Carolina Association of Free and Charitable Clinics, the North Carolina School-Based Health Alliance, and other organizations representative of eligible grant recipients.

The Community Health Grant Program process, informed by the Primary Care Advisory Committee, is a competitive grant that results in three-year awards. The Office of Rural Heath submitted a Legislative Report to satisfy Session Law 2017-57 and Session Law 2021-180 on the establishment of a Primary Care Advisory Committee. As defined in Session Law, the maximum awards are \$150,000 per year. The Program award period aligns with the State Fiscal Year (July 1st through June 30th). The competitive grant process begins with an annual Request for Applications (RFA). The SFY 2024 RFA was released and posted to the ORH website on October 3, 2022. Applications were submitted via an electronic application process and were due on December 2, 2022. Eligible applications are organized within the six Medicaid regions and scored by a team of reviewers. The highest scoring applications from each Medicaid region are awarded. This process ensures that funding distribution is equitable across the State. The demand for the Community Health Grant Program is substantial. On average, the program funding supports awards to approximately 43% of eligible applicants.

In compliance with Session Law, the below information and tables are respectfully submitted. Awards are separated into three categories. New Awards were generated by the competitive application cycle that opened on October 3, 2022, and closed on December 2, 2022. The new awards are documented in Table 1. Continuation awards that began Year 2 of their three-year

award are documented in Table 2, and continuation awards that began Year 3 of their three-year award are documented in Table 3. In the Tables below, the Total Patients Served data is reported by each grantee to ORH. Grantee organizations can report patient served data into one of the following three categories:

- <u>Sub-Populations</u>: Data from a specific group of patients supported by the grant (i.e. dental patients, maternal care patients, behavioral health, etc.).
- One-Site Population: Data reported will include only those patients seen at a specific practice site location supported by the grant.
- <u>Multi-Sites Population</u>: Data reported will include patients from more than one specific practice site location supported by the grant.

The purpose of each grantee defining their patient served populations as a sub-population, a one-site population or a multi-site population is to provide additional information to explain the variations between patients served across grantees. In addition to variations attributed to the grantees' definition of patient population, grantee outcomes can vary due to a multitude of differences, including but not limited to practice operations, primary care provider challenges, operational expenses, location of service delivery sites, hours of operation, and the complexity of care provided to high need populations. School-Based Health Care Centers historically have lower patients served due to their patient population, location of service delivery, and travel.
