There is no match on this grant.	runds for this project have been awarded with the main objective to identify and field test technological solutions to show that significant finfish bycatch reduction can occur over existing levels with acceptable shrimp loss and to develop outreach materials that communicate study results to the commercial fishing industry. The approach to meeting industry. This will be to first test different bycatch reduction (BRD) devices on order testing through the most common type of traw used in the strimpling industry. This will be done testing a few different types of BRDs by an industry work group. After Initial testing the gears will be tested on commercial shrimp vessels with DMF employees observing and collecting data. The employees will be trained in DMF protocols collecting the data which meet the requirements of federally funded observer projects and largely coincids with NOAA fisheries guidelines.
