JUSTIFICATION FOR REQUEST:

(1)DPI requests to deviate due to the receipt of Federal grant funds (Title I Basic) for budget code 13510. Revision #12-0235 requests new grant funding for 2015-2016 of \$416,412,132 (Awarded by USDE). The Title I Basic Grant's purpose is to provide funding to supplement and provide special help to educationally deprived children from low-income families. Awards are determined by formula and awarded in lengths up to 27 months. This revision will be adjusting the authorized budget to actual amount available to spend for the remainder of the grant. Title I Basic grant funds are received on an annual basis and this transaction, while not always causing a deviation, also occurs on an annual basis.

(2)DPI requests to deviate due to the appropriation of textbook funding for 2015-2016 for budget code 73510 #12-0002 606 requests budget of \$58,246,311. Funds are certified in budget code 13510 and then transferred to budget code 73510 in order to allow for local education agencies to purchase State Board of Education approved textbooks through DPI. This revision also budgets available fund balance. These transaction occurs on an annual basis.
