In May 2015, OSBM reallocated \$1,049,000 in 2013 Reserve for Repairs and Renovations funding in order to address repairs costs resulting from flooding in the Dobbs Building that occurred when a water supply pipe connection separated. The Dobbs Building emergency repairs have been completed and a surplus remains.
