Expenditures for Emergency Capital Projects --- UNC-Chapel Hill SUBJECT:

In accordance with G.S. 120-76.1 the following expenditures were approved without consulting the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations because of an emergency that posed an imminent threat to public health or public safety.

UNC-Chapel Hill: Emergency Capital Improvement Declaration

Emergency Justification for Steele Building Mold Abatement and Waterproofing

The University's Environment, Health and Safety Department (EHS) initially reported the presence of mold in rooms located on the ground floor of the Steele Building. We evacuated the occupants and hired an outside contractor to begin mold remediation. Their remediation and our investigations have revealed vulnerabilities in the exterior waterproofing.

In order to reduce the relocation time for our Academic Advising group who occupy this space it is necessary to implement emergency contracting procedures to expedite the design and implementation of the exterior waterproofing. The work will be scheduled as soon as the design documents are prepared.

The estimated cost is \$300,000. The University will provide non-recurring funds for this effort.
