Pursuant to the requirements of the Clean Water and Natural Gas Critical Needs Bond Act of 1998 (S.L. 1998-132), I have enclosed a copy of the report on grant activity for FY 2012 through FY 2016.

The Clean Water Bond categories include:

- 1. The Unsewered Communities Grant Program extended grants to unsewered communities to eliminate the use of outhouses, straight piping or extreme failure of septic systems.
- 2. The Supplemental Grant Program extended supplemental grants for critically needed water and sewer projects.
- 3. The Capacity Building Grant Program extended grants for the planning needed to make strategic investments in water and sewer infrastructure projects.
- 4. The Capacity Construction Grant Program extended grants for critically needed water and sewer construction projects, utilizing the remaining Capacity Building Grants Program funds.

The attached report summarizes Clean Water Bond grant activity for the past five years. The status of each category is noted, and the total payments made are as of June 30, 2016.
