To Whom It May Concern:

In accordance with Section 120-157.2(a) of the General Statutes of North Carolina as amended, the Town of Beech Mountain hereby notifies you of its intent to enter into a State Revolving Fund Loan with the Division of Water Infrastructure in the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality subject to the approval of the Local Government Commission, in the expected amount of \$2,961,490.

<u>Purpose of Proiect</u>: The purpose of the proposed project is to improve a major portion of the collection system tributary to the Pond Creek WWTP. Improvements will involve repair, rehabilitation, and replacements as needed to restore original system function and reliability.

Scope of Project: The project consists of completing investigations and assessments to determine asset conditions and rehab/repair recommendations. This includes CCTV of approximately 23,100 LF of 8-inch and 3,800 LF of 12-inch gravity sewer; smoke test 12,620 LF of gravity sewer; rehabilitation of 6,000 LF of 8-inch, 800 LF of 12-inch gravity sewer and 150 manholes; replacement of 1,000 LF of 8-inch and 12-inch gravity sewer; raise 40 manholes; 40 point repairs; and 60 sewer services.

<u>Debt Requirement of the Project:</u> The projected capital cost of the 2023 Sewer Main Improvements Project is \$2,961,490, all of which is to be debt financed.

Means of Financing the Project: The project is to be financed through a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan at a maximum interest rate of 1.76% over 20 years, subject to availability and conditions of the funding program.

<u>Sources of Repayment for the Project</u>: The SRP loan principal and interest will be repaid using funds collected by the Town from its current customer base, through normal fees. Increases in these normal fees may be necessary in the near future but we anticipate such fees to remain below 4% of the Median Household Income for our service area (for those customers using 5,000 gallons per month or less).
