Subject: Proposed renewal fee increase for **chiropractic radiologic technologists**

Pursuant to G.S. 12-3.1, the Board of Chiropractic Examiners respectfully submits the following report in support of a proposed fee increase:

- (a) Amount of Current Fee. Chiropractic radiologic technologists are employees of chiropractic clinics whose job duties include the taking of patient X-rays. They are required by law to obtain fifty hours of training, pass a proficiency examination, and maintain a certificate of competency issued by the Board of Chiropractic Examiners. This certificate must be renewed annually, and **the current renewal fee is \$20.00.**
- (b) <u>Amount of Increase.</u> The Board proposes to increase the renewal fee by \$10.00 so that the fee would be \$30.00, rather than \$20.00.
- (c) <u>Statutory Authority.</u> Statutory authority is found in N.C.G.S. 90-143.2(b), which states that the renewal fee shall not be more than \$50.00.
- (d) <u>Explanation of Need.</u> The current fee was established in 2004 and is no longer adequate to cover the administrative costs incurred in processing renewal applications.
