

**The North Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc.  
NC FFA Foundation State Appropriations annual report  
July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 report**

The funding by the state of North Carolina has provided financial support for the North Carolina FFA Foundation and the North Carolina FFA Center through The North Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc. Funding has been used to finish the construction of the staff house and the boys' cabins at the North Carolina FFA Center.

Funds from the 2023-2024 fiscal year were spent to help finish the rebuild of the boys' cabins and construct a new staff house at the NC FFA Center. The cabins were completely enclosed with air conditioning and a half bath added for the students. The rebuild also expanded capacity from 15 campers to 16 campers in each of the ten cabins at the NC FFA Center. The new staff house is a facility that can be used year-round by FFA chapters, camp staff, and community groups. Funds were also utilized to purchase needed household items such as mattresses, furniture, and appliances.

More than 6,000 students, teachers, government agencies, civic groups, and guests continue to utilize the facility annually. Projects at the NC FFA Center directly impact more than 83,000 students enrolled in Agricultural Education and more than 630 Agricultural Education teachers in North Carolina.
