The Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services has received federal funding from the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Cures Act to address the opioid crisis in our State. Pursuant to applicable law, we are informing the Commission of this grant award. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, we project actual expenditures will not exceed \$2,500,000. In view of the magnitude of the crisis and the need for prompt response, I am reporting that I have authorized the timely budgeting and expenditure of grant funding to address the opioid epidemic. The Notice of Award from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) is attached for your reference.
