## Dear Members:

G.S. § 1-617(b) requires the Attorney General to submit to the Joint Legislative Committee on Governmental Operations and the Chairs of the Appropriations Subcommittees on Justice and Public Safety an annual report on the number of qui tam cases under the North Carolina False Claims Act (G.S. § 1-605 through 1-618) pending in the State and the number of qui tam cases pending in other jurisdictions involving the State, the number of qui tam cases under the North Carolina False Claims Act that were settled, the number of qui tam cases in which judgment was entered, and the amount of proceeds paid to qui tam plaintiffs during the previous calendar year.

For the period January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017, the Attorney General's report pursuant to G.S. § 1-617(b) is as follows:

Qui tam cases pending in North Carolina as of 12/31/2017	36
Qui tam cases pending in other jurisdictions involving claims under the North Carolina False Claims Act as of 12/31/2017	241
Qui tam cases under the North Carolina False Claims Act settled in 2017	12
Qui tam cases under the North Carolina False Claims Act in which judgment was entered	0
Amount of proceeds paid to qui tam plaintiffs in 2017	\$1,701,246.27
