SUBJECT: Expenditures for Emergency Capital Projects --- UNC Chapel Hill

In accordance with G.S. 120-76.1 the following expenditures were approved without consulting the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations because of an emergency that posed an imminent threat to public health or public safety.

<u>University of North Carolina – Chapel Hill: Emergency Capital Improvement Declaration</u>

One of the Philips Hall air handling units failed due to age and the second unit is operating at reduced capacity. The air handling units were constructed in 1964 and many of the components are original to the units. Philips Hall houses research labs for the Physics Department and also includes classrooms that are in use year-round. The repairs need to be made before the start of the summer term. The University expects the project to cost \$800,000 and will be using facilities and administrative receipts for the repair.
