RE: Proposed fee increases for licensed Physician Assistants

At its July 2018 Board meeting, the NC Medical Board voted to increase the renewal and application fees for Physician Assistants.

The revenues generated by the proposed rules are approximations.

The proposed fees will provide revenue to enable the North Carolina Medical Board to carry out its statutory function to regulate Physician Assistants in North Carolina for the benefit and protection of the public.

The proposed fee increase is the first increase for the physician assistants since 2005. During this 13-year interval, physician fees have been increased twice. The proposed fee increase for physician assistants is proportionate to the latest fee increase borne by physicians.
