Purpose of grant or amendment 31 Comments	The purpose of this grant is to 1) improve access to treatment and support services for young people 16-25 years of age who have a serious emotional disturbance or serious mental illness and 2) to improve the behavioral and emotional functioning of the young people served. For both selected communities, we know that poverty and trauma/adverse experiences contribute to vulnerability in developing serious mental illness while the experiences of historical traumas on the Qualla boundary adds additional risk. This project will need to address all forms of trauma, co-occurring substance use from untreated mental illness, and the developmental reluctance of emerging Adults to seek services. To address these issues this proposal includes outreach, assessment, youth peer partners with lived experience to connect young people to services, training, consultation, and the use of local teams to develop culturally appropriate plans to plan recovery supports (especially housing options), additional treatment supports and family peer support.
