Dear Mr. Greene:

Thank you for your recent email. If interested in background information regarding this or other programmatic agreements, please find attached a copy of the fully executed Programmatic Agreement for the Atlantic Coast Pipeline. This has been redacted as it contains sensitive archaeological information.

I also provide the links to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's (ACHP) materials on programmatic agreements. ACHP is the federal agency responsible for ensuring that Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act is followed.

Our Historic Preservation Office does not approve federal actions or issue permits for federal undertakings. We consult with federal agencies, which are responsible for carrying out 106 activities. Programmatic agreements are not permits or approvals. This agreement simply sets out a process to follow, if historic resources were identified and could be potentially adversely affected during construction.

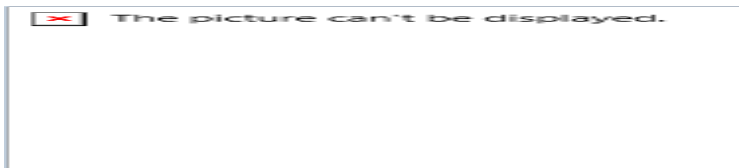
